CONDITIONS:

BUNDLES & PACKAGES QUALIFICATIONS

These conditions are for our listed options. We are happy to customize to meet different needs. Changes like adding to our setup or teardown schedule, additional services, or conditions not being met will result in additional fees beyond our listed prices & should be negotiated well in advance of the performance date.

VIP Orchestra has at least 20 musicians. Grand Orchestra package includes instrumentation in the mid-teens. Great Orchestra has approximately 10 musicians. Maestro Orchestras have rhythm & voice with a small horns/strings section. Amplified bundles include a large event P/A unless listed as compact.

Combined ceremony & reception bundles require processing of a 50% deposit accompanied by a signed contract a minimum of 4 months in advance of the performance.

Rates are for performances within 50 miles of the St. Louis Arch. Additional travel can be negotiated.

Maximum 10 miles relocating between the ceremony & reception venues with adequate time to teardown, travel, & fully setup & sound check at the next location. Reception music is limited to one location.

Minimum 6 hours setup time is required for larger bands. Minimum 1-hour setup time for string quartet.

String quartet will perform as an acoustic ensemble. Amplification is available for additional fees.

String quartet may have a musician switch between violin & piano, vocals, or guitar upon availability.

Outdoor performances require protection from direct sunlight, precipitation, heat and cold.

Rehearsal attendance is not included in the above options but can be negotiated for additional fees.

Custom song arrangements require a minimum 4 months advance notice. Arrangements can be for the band or string quartet, or one for each. Songs of advanced lengths or complexity will require additional fees.

Up to 10 DJ song requests may be made with at least one month's advanced notice. Clients may send audio files properly formatted at least one month in advance for the DJ to prepare in their cue.

Master of Ceremonies, also known as MC or emcee services may include every announcement & introduction provided instructions are filled out using our wedding reception planner document.

Ceremony & reception planning documents must be completed and received no less than 2 months in advance of any performance. Musicians reserve the right to adhere to scheduling, song selections, & other aspects of the performance as deemed suitable to the event if planners are not provided 2 months in advance.

A microphone for toasts & speeches can be added to the P/A at no additional charge upon advance request.

Our orchestra is incredibly versatile with arrangements for up to around 100 musicians. We will gladly assist in selecting instruments based on your preferences for styles, budget & band size.

For events with smaller bands, we recommend instrumentations based on what will sound best for the music selected & match the ambient energy of the event. For upbeat dance music we typically provide a singer/guitar/keyboard player plus bass, drums, & other instruments. Jazz combos usually have our singer/guitar/keyboard player & add saxophone, trumpet, violin, & trombone. For country, fiddle is usually the first instrument we add. We suggest more harmony playing instruments for background & seated music.

LOGISTICS:

SETUP INFORMATION

Clients (you) are responsible for coordinating our setup & teardown schedules with your venue & other vendors before requesting a contract. If the timeframes we need are not available our rates may need to be revised to compensate for additional staff & or hours. We place this responsibility in our clients' hands since multiple vendors may need customized rates remunerated by you.

Large ensembles need at least 4 hours for our roadies to load in, setup, & store our empty cases. The area should be free of other vendors' personnel, performers, or public traffic during this time. Soundcheck & tuning need to occur shortly before every performance & usually include the full band, arriving shortly before the performance. It may be preferable to setup sound & lights a day prior to the performance. If so, please email us to make those arrangements. Roadies typically require two to three hours to teardown.

Acoustic ensembles & soloists usually require a minimum of 90 minutes to setup, 60 to teardown.

Our truck, trailer & other equipment vehicles usually need at least four parking spots reserved at the loading dock or point of ingress nearest the performance area. Our truck with trailer needs about 50' in length & is over 8' tall, too tall to fit in most passenger vehicle sized covered parking lots & garages.

Most events employ a mobility-limited musician so a handicapped parking space nearest the stage is much appreciated. We also use a federally registered service dog roadie to assist with hauling our equipment. Our website has an entire blog page dedicated to Munchkin in case you require more information.

The industry standard is for musicians to be given breaks of 15 minutes after every 45 minutes of
performing. This enables musicians to continue performing for extended periods. If you hire our DJ breal
music service, we can play recorded music while the musicians are not performing. If the standard break
schedule does not fit your needs, please specify.

BAND MEALS:

It is customary for musicians to receive complimentary food and nonalcoholic beverages. If a full meal is not available many caterers offer a boxed meal. The band usually takes its longest break during their meal. Musicians need at least 20 minutes to eat before putting air through their horns again. During blessings, toasts, & speeches can be a good opportunity for musicians to dine. Having the musicians dine after one or two dance sets is another common option.

The number of roadies varies depending on the requirements of the event but usually includes a minimum of three roadies in addition to our musicians. Roadie duties at smaller events can usually be handled by just our service dog.
